

# 2016 U.S. Soccer National C Courses – Frequently Asked Questions

Please note, all inquiries should first be directed to the [state course administrator](#).

## What are the specific dates of the course?

Meeting 1: July 24-31, 2016 – Lancaster, Massachusetts

Development Period: In between the two meetings, candidates will complete assignments and practical work in their home environment while collaborating with the instructors remotely.

Meeting 2: November 11-13, 2016 – Lancaster, Massachusetts

## Can I attend the first meeting in one location, and the second meeting in another?

No – candidates must commit to attending both scheduled meetings as arranged by the host organization. Failure to attend the second meeting as scheduled will result in a failing grade for the course.

## Who is eligible to attend a National C course?

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and have held the “D” License for a minimum of 12 months.

## If I don't meet the prerequisite, can I be granted an exception to attend a National C course?

1. Please carefully review the [FLPP application](#). If your background fits the eligibility guidelines, you may submit the application directly to the [course administrator](#). *Do not send your application directly to U.S. Soccer.*
2. The course administrator will perform an initial review, and forward appropriate applications to U.S. Soccer.
3. You will be notified via email if your application is accepted and ONLY if space is available in the course. *Please note: candidates who hold the U.S. Soccer National D license will be given priority.*

## How do I register?

The initial registration process will be handled by the host organization - please see the [contact information](#) on the course schedule for each specific course. Coaches should already have or should create a profile in the [Digital Coaching Center \(DCC\)](#) to ensure their profile is complete and up to date.

## How much do the courses cost?

Course fees will be listed for each individual course once registration information is posted. Please see the [contact information](#) on the course schedule for each specific course.

## I'm not currently coaching a team. Can I still apply for a course?

Applicants who are not currently coaching are highly encouraged to gain experience with the appropriate age group prior to starting the registration process.

## Am I required to complete any tasks prior to the first meeting?

Any required initial assignments for the course have yet to be determined. Candidates will be given sufficient time to complete their work.
