Please read this form carefully and completely, as there have been a number of changes from previous years. Only current reservation forms will be accepted. Reservation forms from previous years will be discarded.

Housing Information:

A limited number of residence hall rooms will be available for rent to participants of the MYSA Soccer Tournament June 22-24, 2007. A typical residence hall room is arranged to provide each occupant with a dresser, desk, chair, and unmade single bed. No linen, pillows or blankets will be provided. Residence halls are not air-conditioned. The residence hall rooms do not have telephones. Public bathroom facilities are centrally located on each floor. Coin operated laundry facilities and a pay phone are available. Twenty-four hour desk coverage is provided. Pets are not allowed.

The cost for these accommodations is **\$60.00** per room for single occupancy and **\$100.00** per room for double occupancy. **Please note that this fee is for the use of the building for both nights.** Should a team not advance and wish to leave Saturday night, there will be no reduction in fee and all keys must be returned by the coach or designated affiliate. Individual key returns will not be accepted. Make checks payable to: Summer Conference Housing, CS# 08-60.

Reservation Information:

The attached reservation form must be returned to University Conference Services **no later than Friday, June 15, 2007.** **Reservation forms received after this date could be ineligible for housing.** This timeline will allow us to clean and prepare the residence hall. There should be only one registration form for each entire team, completed by the team's coach. Individual requests for reservations will not be accepted. To make a reservation, please complete this form and be sure to include a credit card number. Reservations will not be held without a credit card guarantee, regardless of the method of payment. In the event that you do not check in to the residence hall, one half of the team fee will be charged against the credit card provided. Payment must be made IN FULL by the team's coach, or some designated affiliate. It will be the responsibility of this party to collect payment from individual team members.

NO INDIVIDUAL PAYMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Traveler's checks, personal checks, or credit cards will be accepted as payment. ***A credit card number is required to guarantee the reservation regardless of the method of payment preferred.*** The total amount for housing will be charged upon receipt of the reservation. Checks mailed from outside of the United States must be redeemable at a United States bank or the reservation will not be processed and the check will be returned.

A \$10.00 charge will be assessed for each key lost. The total amount for lost keys will be charged to the credit card provided at reservation. **NO CASH OR CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

Check-in time will be after 4:00pm, June 22, 2007, and checkout time will be by 11:00am, June 24, 2007, without exception. Members found in the building after checkout time (11am) will incur a charge of one half of the daily rate ***for the entire team.***

General Information:

Athletic Fields: MYSA/MTOC has contracted directly with University Athletics for playing fields and facilities.

Housing: MYSA/MTOC has not contracted with Conference Services for housing. All housing is being contracted on a per team basis. Housing will be in the Southwest Residential Area, Washington Tower. Inappropriate guest behavior, such as playing sports of any kind in hallways, moving furniture, excessive noise or constant disruption of other guests, or alcohol in any area of the dormitory, will result in the entire team being asked to leave immediately with no refund.

Food Service: MYSA has not contracted for food services with University Dining Services. There is a snack bar located in the Campus Center that will be open between the hours of 7:30am and 7:00pm each day. There are also several restaurants within a reasonable distance from campus.

Parking: Lot 33, located in close proximity to the residence hall, has been designated for your group. There will be no charge for the use of this lot. However, cars parked on the grass, in tow zones, in designated staff, vendor, or handicapped parking spaces, loading zones, or in any lot in which a proper permit is required are subject to ticketing and towing. Accommodations will be made to allow guests to unload their cars in a designated area in front of the residence hall, but vehicles should not be left in this area while luggage, etc. is carried to guest rooms. Unattended vehicles in this area run the risk of ticketing and towing. Please bear this in mind during your arrival, stay, and departure.
