Mass Youth ODP COACHING STAFF QUALIFICATIONS

GUIDELINES:

All Mass Youth ODP Staff Coaches are appointed by the Mass Youth ODP State Director of Coaching, and the ODP, Director. They are then subject to the approval of the Mass Youth Board of Directors. All ODP hiring is done in July for the up coming year that starts in August with tryouts. Please look at the previous years training schedule to see if you are able to make the commitment to the program.

Head Coach

1. Must first abide by and uphold the "Mass Youth Code of Ethics" and have a demonstrative history of such a standard of behavior.
2. Must hold at minimum a **USSF "B"** License or an equivalent license and be actively working to attain USSF certification (i.e. a NSCAA Advanced National Diploma and/or a recognized FIFA equivalent)
3. Must have soccer playing experience at a high level (at least collegiate and/or semi-professional recommended);
4. Must have coaching experience at a high level (Club, College, or Professional)
5. Must come well-recommended.

Assistant Coach

1. Must first abide by and uphold the "Mass Youth Code of Ethics" and have a demonstrative history of such a standard of behavior.
2. Must hold at minimum a **USSF "C"** License or an equivalent license and be actively working to attain USSF certification (i.e. a NSCAA National Diploma and/or a recognized FIFA equivalent)
3. Must have soccer playing experience at a high level (at least collegiate and/or semi-professional recommended);
4. Must have coaching experience at a high level (Club, College, or Professional)
5. Must come well recommended.
