



TSL Match Day Protocols

- Two (2) adults (parents/guardians or chaperones) and siblings per each participating player. These spectators must enter, sit and leave as a “family unit”.
- We have a no pet policy on all of our game day locations.
- Use of tobacco products, vaping, cannabis are strictly prohibited
- All players, participants, and spectators must wear face coverings and Social Distance at all times. Face coverings must be worn once entering the property until they leave the property for the day **regardless of being fully vaccinated.**
- All Players and Spectators should bring their own individual folding chair and socially distance 6 ft apart from other spectators.
- Spectators may drop players off up no earlier than 30 minutes prior to kick-off, but should not enter spectator areas until 15 minutes prior to kick-off on the field they are playing on. Spectators are asked to wait in their car and then proceed to the field 15 minutes before kick-off.
- Players, Coaches and Spectators will leave the playing area immediately after games are completed to allow time for warm-ups in following games. The away team will depart first, followed by the home team 5 minutes later.
- Spectators are not to gather on or around another organization’s game, field, or match.

- Spectators will be asked to leave the facility if derogatory comments are made towards the referee or opposition players/staff.
- It is the responsibility of the parent, coach, and player to supply their own PPE in preparation of the matches. Mass Youth Soccer nor the TSL will not be distributing any PPE for individuals. **Players are advised to always pack multiple masks in their bag for the day.**
- Please properly dispose of all used PPE in the trash receptacles on the complex.
- By attending a TSL game located at the Mass Youth Soccer Complex, all players, coaches, spectators and officials are self-certifying that:
 - 1) They have checked their temperature on the date of the game with a reading below 100.4
 - 2) Are free from all signs and symptoms of COVID-19
 - 3) Have not been in close contact or exposed to an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19
