



Migration information – 2019-2020

Stack Sports migrated your organization's adult members registration data from Fall 2019 – Spring 2020 into the New U.S. Soccer registration system (old Affinity); this data was placed into the Fall 2019 – Spring 2020 registration year. Mass Youth Soccer added your player registration data for that same year into the new registration system; this provides our member organizations with continuous registration data for both adults and players since Fall 2015.

This means that adults that were registered in the current U.S. Soccer Connect system for Fall 2019 – Spring 2020 and adults that were registered in the (old Affinity) new U.S. Soccer Connect system will register as **“Returning Users” for the Fall 2020 – Spring 2021** registration year.

Adults that were new to Mass Youth Soccer for the Fall 2019 – Spring 2020 registration year, and those that were previously registered in the old Affinity system and do not remember their username or password will use the **“Forgot Password”** function to connect to their old registration/uploaded information and should **wait for the reply email prior to moving forward with their adult registration**. If the adult was registered in the (old Affinity) new U.S. Soccer Connect system and knows their username and password, they will simply complete the registration process for this new soccer registration year as a returning user.

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NOTE: If the SafeSport abuse prevention and CDC concussion training approvals did not meet the policy guidelines for the now opened Fall 2020 – Spring 2021 registration year (valid through the complete registration year that the adult is registering to), we deleted that data, which in turn unverified this field in the adult's new account.

If the adult is checked as verified/approved in the new U.S. Soccer Connect registration system based on migrated data, you will not see a certificate uploaded for them; we could not migrate documents into the new system. Technically, no action would be needed by you as the Administrator, because the adult is verified/approved based on the upload date data that was available to Mass Youth Soccer at that time.

Migrated information includes your adult members name, date of birth, email address, and **may include**:

- a. SafeSport Abuse Prevention training approval date.
- b. Center for Disease Control Concussion (CDC) training approval date.
 - a. **IMPORTANT**: CDC moved online training and requires more information for account set up; you cannot access old accounts (those completed March 1st, 2020 or earlier). This information is posted on both the Adult Registration and Risk Manager Information webpages.
 - b. All adults should save both training certificates of approval on their computer so if needed, they can upload them onto the new registration system and **if they meet the criteria for approval**, you can manually approve them.
- c. CORI Verification date.
- d. Background Check/Risk Status and Expire Date.

NOTE: Mass Youth Soccer requires all adults to complete an online Adult Registration annually.
