

When registering for the Massachusetts Youth Soccer ESports Tournaments, players willingly agree to comply with the following terms, rules and conditions for participation:

- a) Player Communications - Massachusetts Youth Soccer does not monitor or block chat functions, comments, or other communications made by players on the Massachusetts Youth Soccer ESports website or host consoles (XBOX or Playstation). However, it is recommended that players do not share personal information with other players on any platform that they do not wish to be made public (e.g., name, personal cell-phone number, address, etc.). In addition, any abusive or obscene language used in communications on the Massachusetts Youth Soccer ESports website, Discord, Twitch or host console may lead to disqualification of the offending player, and denial of access to the website.
- b) Information Collection and Use – Massachusetts Youth Soccer ESports collects information from our users by several different methods, including its website and registration forms, and is the sole owner of the data so collected. In each case, only information that is reasonably necessary to participate in the Massachusetts Youth Soccer activity at hand will be collected. We will never condition an underage player's participation in an online activity on the disclosure of information that is beyond what is reasonably necessary for Massachusetts Youth Soccer to conduct the relevant activity.

Data from the Massachusetts Youth Soccer ESports website and related sources may be further used by Massachusetts Youth Soccer to contact the player about Massachusetts Youth Soccer products, news, promotions and events. Players can opt out of receiving marketing emails from Massachusetts Youth Soccer or may contact Massachusetts Youth Soccer with questions regarding the use of their personal data by sending an e-mail stating their name and e-mail address to marketing@mayouthsoccer.org together with request to opt-out of marketing emails or with their question.

- c) Demographic Information Sharing - Massachusetts Youth Soccer may accumulate and store aggregated demographic information about website users. This information is not linked or otherwise traceable to any identifiable personal information of the players, and is used solely to advise website partners and advertisers of the site's general audience characteristics, and to track responses to online programs and activities.

When called upon to do so, Massachusetts Youth Soccer will disclose information received as required by law, such as in response to a court order or other specific requests by law enforcement agencies.

- d) Video & Photo Release - When registering for Massachusetts Youth Soccer ESports events, Players hereby grant Massachusetts Youth Soccer permission to use their likeness in a photograph, video, or other digital reproduction in any and all of its publications, including website entries, without payment or any other consideration. Players further give permission to Massachusetts Youth Soccer to use this image or video in any and all of its publications, advertising and promotions, including website entries, without payment or other consideration. Players understand and agree that all such media and related materials will become the property of Massachusetts Youth Soccer and will not be returned. Players hereby irrevocably authorize Massachusetts Youth Soccer to edit, alter, copy, exhibit, publish or distribute these photos and videos and related materials for purposes of publicizing and promoting its programs,

or for any other lawful purpose. In addition, Players waive the right to inspect or approve the finished product, including written or electronic copy, wherein their likeness appears. Players hereby hold harmless and release and forever discharge Massachusetts Youth Soccer from all claims, demands, and causes of action that they, or their heirs, representatives, executors, administrators or any other persons acting on my behalf or on behalf of their estate, have or may have by reason of this authorization.

Player represents that he/she is competent to contract in his/her own name, and that he/she has read this release and fully understands the contents, meaning, and impact of this release.

- e) Policy on Minors - Massachusetts Youth Soccer Gaming allows minors under the age of 18 to participate in online competitions and tournaments. By checking "I agree to the following attendee agreements from the Tournament Organizers: Waiver" box, upon registration, the parent or legal guardian of the under-aged player has confirmed that he or she has read the Massachusetts Youth Soccer *Gaming Waiver Agreement* in its entirety and has given full consent for his under-aged player to participate.

Massachusetts Youth Soccer Gaming does not collect personally identifiable information from minors under the age of 13 without parental or guardian consent. If a parent or legal guardian becomes aware that his or her child or ward under the age of 13 has provided Massachusetts Youth Soccer with personal information without the parent's consent, then the parent should delete the account and notify Massachusetts Youth Soccer. If Massachusetts Youth Soccer becomes aware that a child under the age of 13 has provided us with personal information without such consent, we will delete such information from our files.

- f) Cookies - A cookie is data stored on the user's hard drive containing information about the user. Usage of cookies on the Massachusetts Youth Soccer website is in no way linked to any personally identifiable information of Players on our site, and is used for website function purposes only.
- g) Log Files - Massachusetts Youth Soccer may use Internet Protocol ('IP') address log files to analyze trends, administer the Massachusetts Youth Soccer Gaming website, track user activity, and gather broad demographic information for aggregate website use. IP addresses are not linked to personally identifiable information.
- h) Security/Links - The Massachusetts Youth Soccer website takes every precaution to protect player information. We do not ask players for more information than is necessary to conduct the various activities being conducted on our website, and all of our information is protected both online and off-line through the use of industry-standard practices.
- i) This Privacy Statement applies solely to information collected by the Massachusetts Youth Soccer website and Esports registration forms. Massachusetts Youth Soccer encourages Players to also to review and understand the privacy policies and information collection practices of other websites that link to and from our website. While Massachusetts Youth Soccer screens our links for overall content, information and entertainment value, we are not responsible for the practices of other websites as they apply to privacy, security, integrity and compliance with the

Children's Online Privacy Protection Act ('COPPA') or any other state or federal laws or regulations.

- j) Notification of Changes - Massachusetts Youth Soccer reserves the right to change this Privacy Policy as necessary, and to comply with state and federal laws, regulations and guidelines. If we do change our Privacy Policy, we will post a prominent link to those changes on the home page of Massachusetts Youth Soccer Esports webpage for ninety (90) days so players are always aware of what information we collect, how we use it, and under what circumstances, if any, we may disclose it. In using information, Massachusetts Youth Soccer will always adhere to the most recent version of this Privacy Policy.
