



Concussion Course ("Introduction to Safe and Healthy Playing Environments")

- Course takes approximately 30 minutes. For your adult registration to be auto approved for the concussion requirement, the course should be taken prior to registering with Mass Youth Soccer via the U.S. Soccer Connect registration platform.
