



U.S. Soccer Learning Center Concussion Training Instructions

Concussion Training Policy:

Mass Youth Soccer has a two-year approval policy for concussion training. If you completed your training June 1st or later, of the prior year you are registering into, you are in fulfillment of the Mass Youth Soccer policy of two years. *For example: for coaches/volunteers in the Fall 2021-Spring 2022 season, training must have been completed June 1, 2020, or later.*

→ Your organization may have a one-year approval policy: it is your responsibility to check with your organization's Risk Manager.

How to Complete the U.S. Soccer Learning Center Concussion Training:

The course takes approximately 30 minutes. For your adult registration to be auto approved, you must use the same legal first and last name and email address when creating both your U.S. Soccer Learning Center and Mass Youth Soccer Adult Registration accounts.

Once the course is completed, log into your [Mass Youth Soccer Adult Registration/U.S. Soccer Connect](#) account and click on your Certificates tab to verify auto-approval of your course completion.

If your Mass Youth Soccer Adult Registration account does not auto-update with the course completion information, use the instructions below.

1. Log into your [Mass Youth Soccer Adult Registration/U.S. Soccer Connect](#) account.
2. Click on the **"Licenses"** tab under your photo.
3. Click on the "GET LEARNING CENTER UPDATES" button at the bottom of the page.
4. Click on the "Certificates" tab; you should see U.S. Soccer Federation (USSF) Learning Center – US Soccer Concussion Training Completed.

5. If you do not see the USSF Learning Center update, verify that your first and last name and email address in your U.S. Soccer Learning Center account matches your Mass Youth Soccer Adult Registration account.
 - a. If name and email address do not match in both accounts, you will need to update an account to establish the connection.
 - b. If all information matches and the account is not auto-updated, call U.S. Soccer Connect Helpline at (855) 703-2558. If they cannot resolve the issue, contact the USSF at learningcentersupport@ussoccer.org.

NOTE: you will not see an expiration date in your adult registration account for training. The expiration date is based on the policy information noted above.

If you see a cloud with an upload arrow, it is time to take/retake that training.

If you see a check mark and 'verified,' you are in compliance for this registration year.
