



Who must complete a Mass Youth Soccer Adult Registration and all required Risk Management trainings?

All participating adults (persons age 18 and older)

Every adult member of all organizations affiliated with Massachusetts Youth Soccer must complete their Mass Youth Soccer Adult Registration, be CORI and National Background Check Approved/Cleared, State and National Sex Offender Registry Search Cleared, and have completed and passed both SafeSport Abuse Prevention and Centers for Disease Control Concussion Training. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Coaches (all types)
- Team Managers, including designated parents with assigned team management responsibilities
- Board Members (Officers, Directors, Administrators, Committee Chairs, Appointees, etc.)
- Referees (Note: All USSF Referees will complete their CORI registration through MSRC)
- Trainers (Permanent or Temporary)
- Volunteers
- Organization Employees
- Concession Workers
- Tournament Organizers, Employees, Volunteers
- **Any other participating person age 18 or older who may have direct and unmonitored access to children.**
